About the course

Conceptual issues relating to gender thread through all aspects of society, including the sciences (popularly assumed to be free from biases) and technologies (commonly considered to be gender neutral). The aim of this course is to examine the mutual shaping of gender and science, technology and innovation in the national systems of innovation in Africa. It will explore how gender gets “imprinted” in new scientific knowledge and new technologies and how women and men encounter the products of science and technology.
